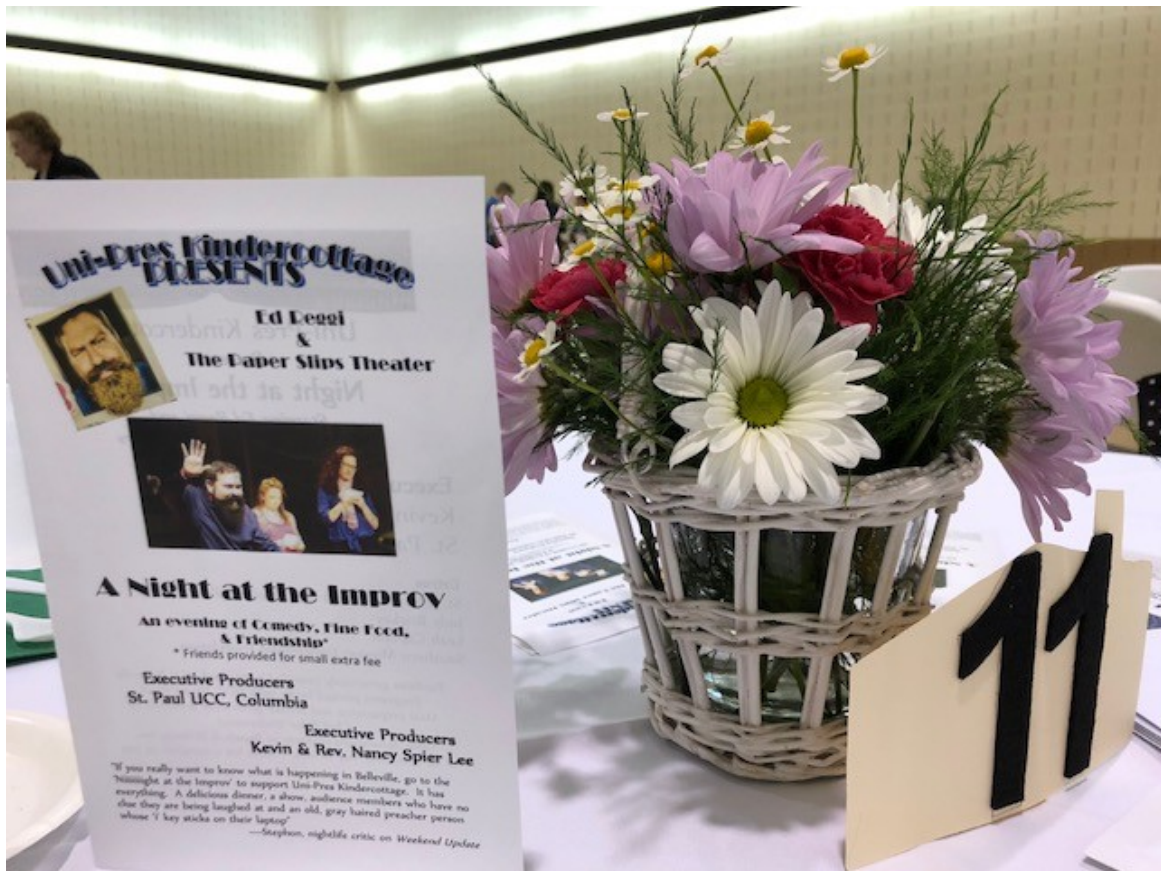
A SUCCESSFUL FUNDRAISER!
